WINDOWS INSTALLATION & SETUP

Windows Version Compatibility:

These instructions are shown using Windows 11. Windows 10 will be very similar. Canon states the driver package is compatible with Windows 8.1. However, this has not been tested.

Architecture Compatibility:

Requires an Intel or AMD processor to function. ARM (Snapdragon) processors use a different type of process and cannot run the software.

STEP 1: OBTAIN [WINDOWS-CANON-PRINTDRIVER.ZIP](#)

This can also be found on the Canon Support website <https://www.usa.canon.com/support>.

Type “C259” in the search box, “imageRUNNER ADVANCE DX C259iF” will be the first available option. Click.

The first listed driver will be Generic_Plus_PCL6_v3.31.zip (last updated 9/23/25 – a newer version may be available.)

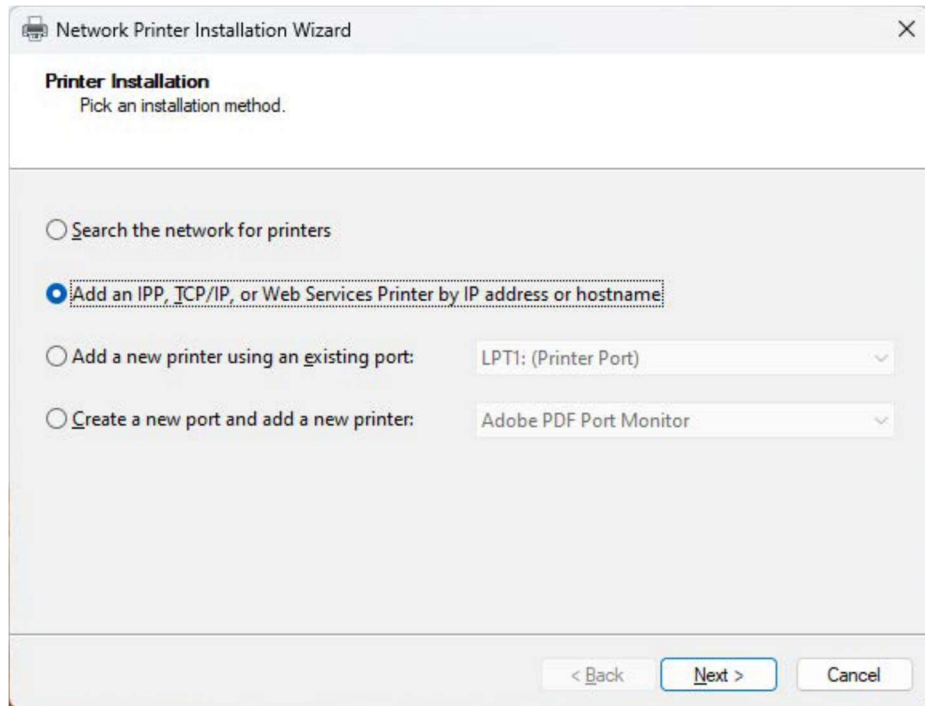
Download this file.

STEP 2: OPEN THE DOWNLOADED ZIP FILE AND RUN PRINTERINSTALL.BAT

A “Yes” / “No” prompt will appear soon after; select “Yes.” A black Command Prompt window will appear and complete the bulk of the installation for you. It may take a couple of minutes for the next window to appear.

STEP 3: FOLLOW THE PROMPTS LISTED BELOW FOR THE PRINTER INSTALLATION. CLICK NEXT ON THE WINDOW THAT HAS OPENED.



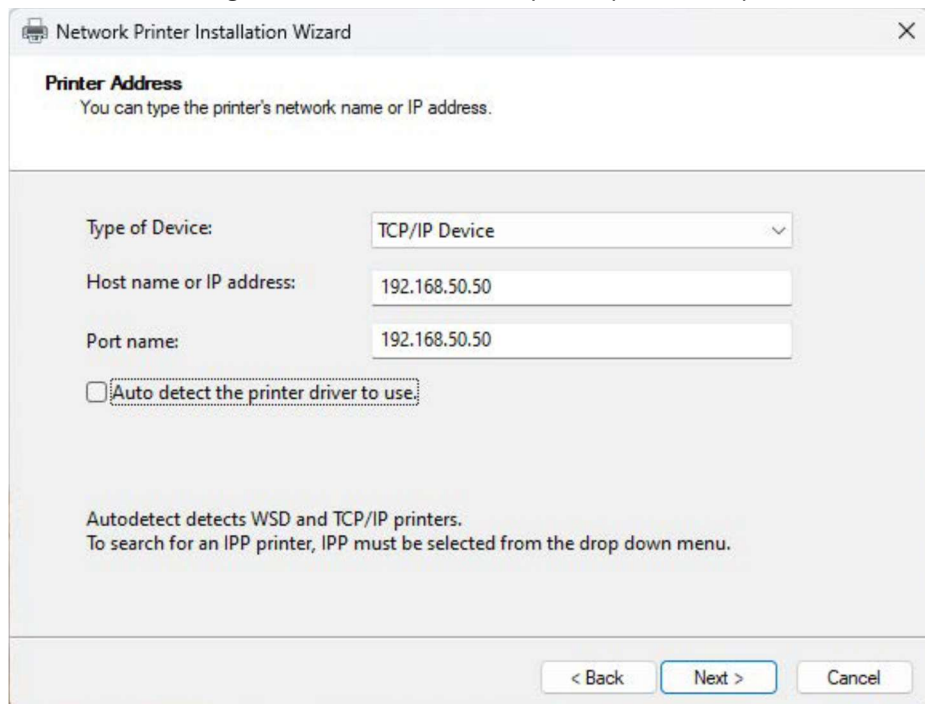
STEP 4: CONFIGURE THE DROP-DOWN BOX TO TCP/IP DEVICE

Enter the IP Address in the provided box.

The 3rd box will automatically fill in based on the previous input. No alteration is needed.

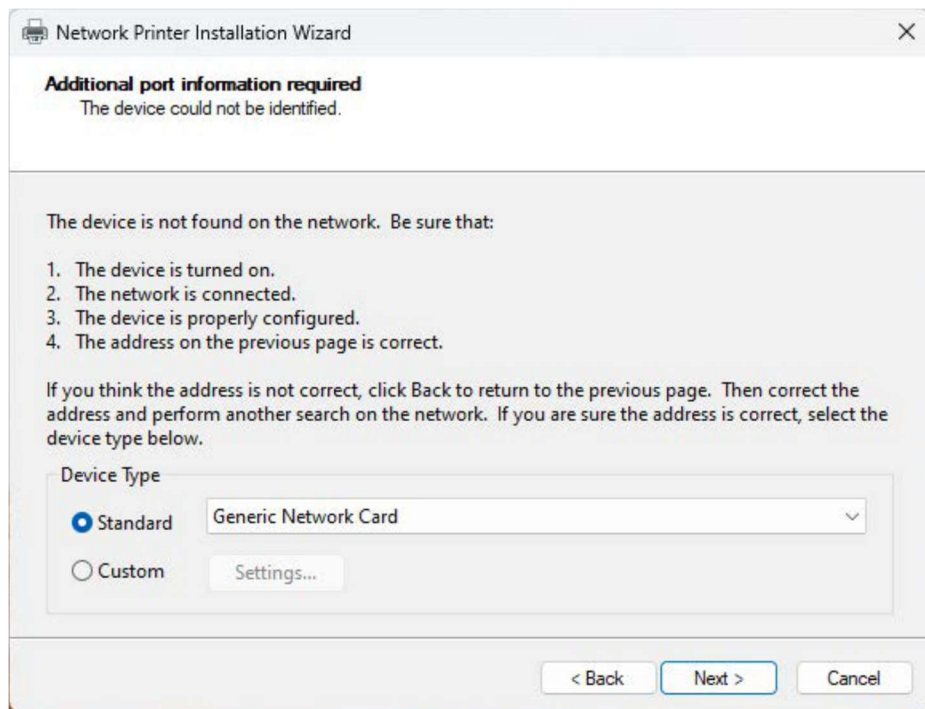
Uncheck "Auto detect the printer driver to use."

Without unchecking the box, Windows will skip multiple vital steps.



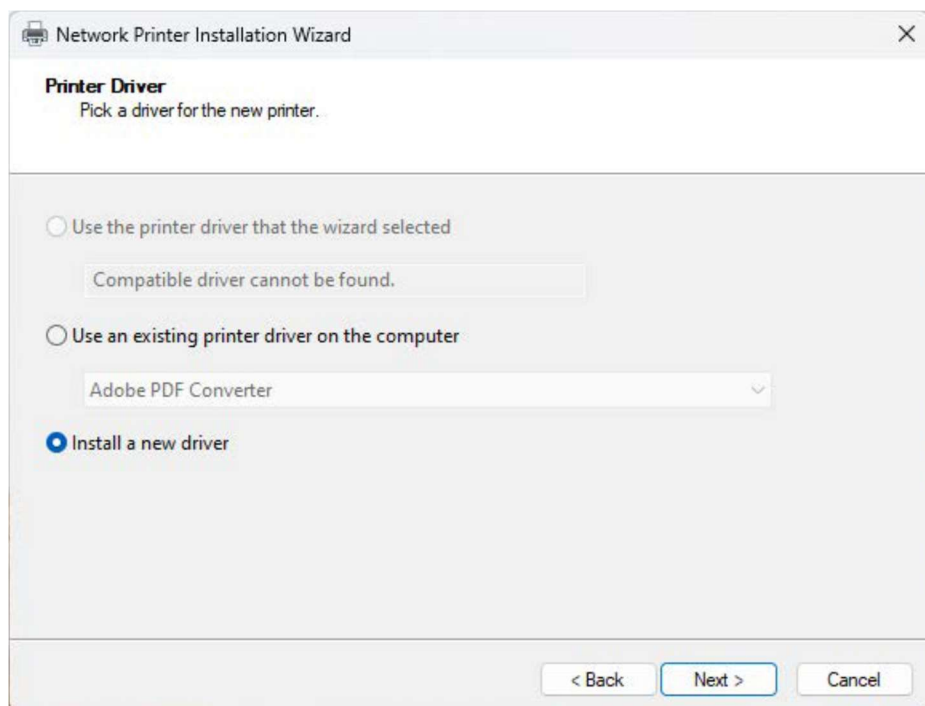
Possible issue: If you are shown the following window. Please verify that you are on the correct network (ProSpace) and that the printer is turned on.

This warning means no response was received from the copier during installation attempts to verify a connection.



STEP 5: TYPICALLY, NO CHANGES ARE NEEDED; YOUR WINDOW SHOULD RESEMBLE THE ONE BELOW.

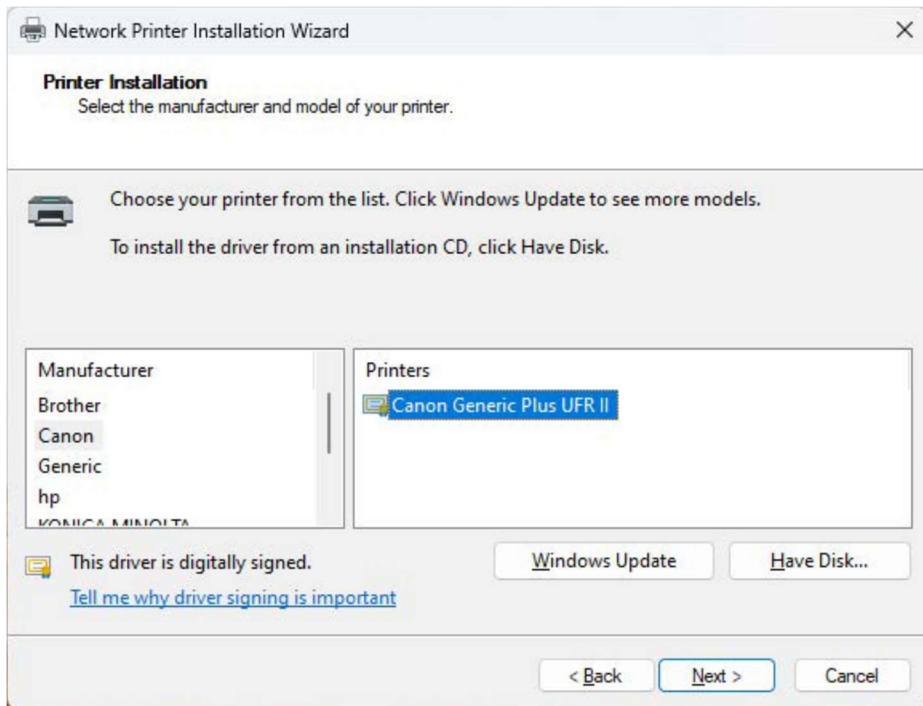
If not, select “Install a new driver” then “Next.”



STEP 6: DRIVER SELECTION

Select “Canon” in the left column.

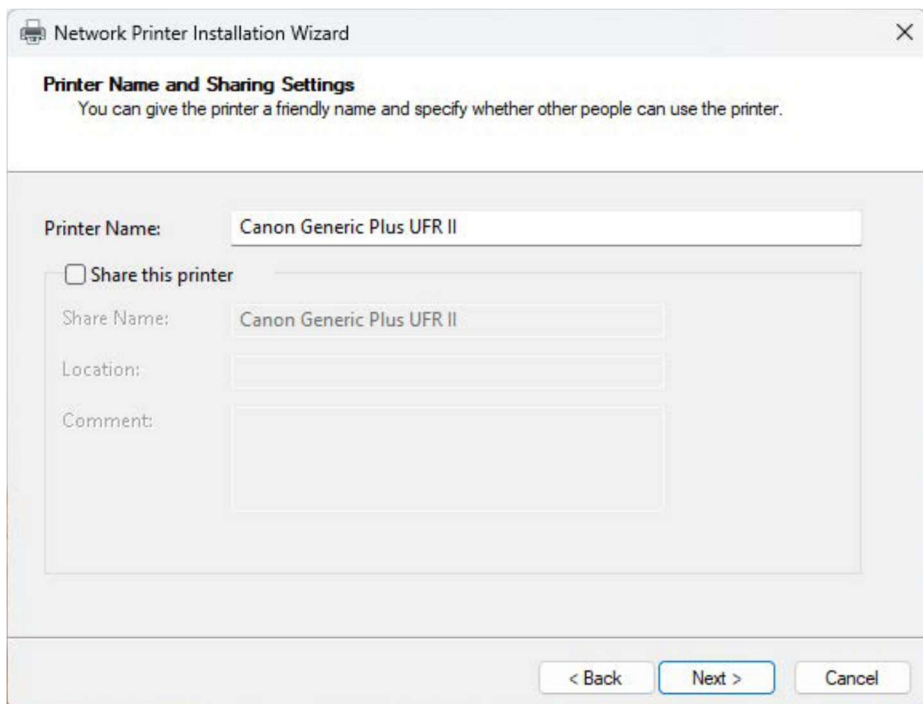
Select “Canon Generic Plus UFR II” in the right column.



STEP 7: NAMING & SHARING

The text box will allow you to name the copier a name of your choosing. This will have no effect on functionality.

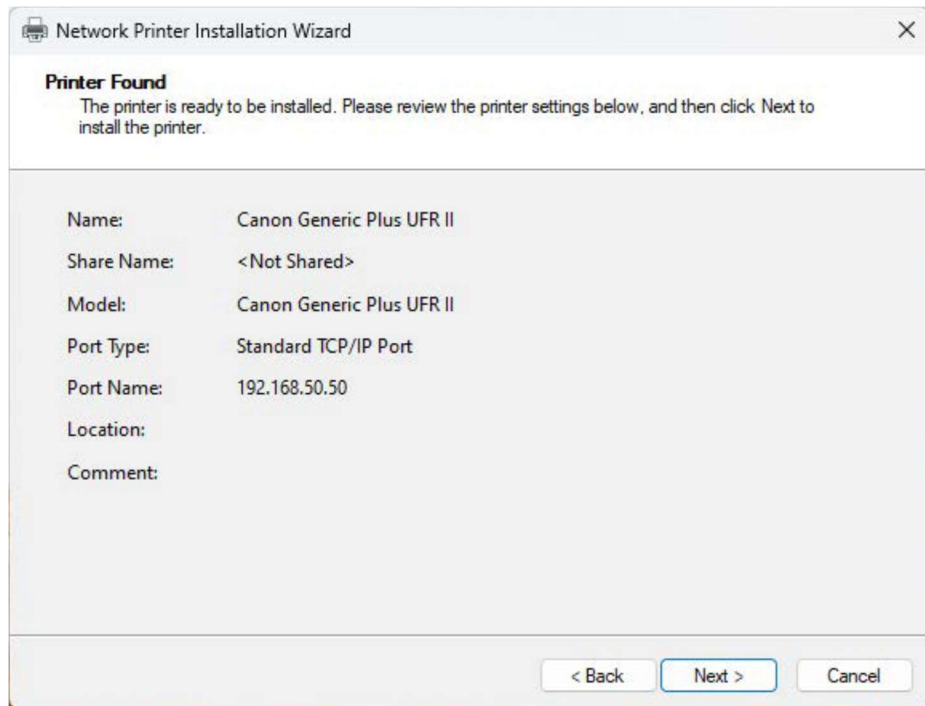
Sharing should be unchecked for security purposes.



STEP 8: CONFIRMATION OF CONFIGURATION

This window confirms all the information entered previously.

Select “Next.”



STEP 9: FINALIZING INSTALLATION

This is the final step, where your computer will use the provided information to configure the printer.

All settings and configurations should be pulled automatically.

INSTALLATION COMPLETE

When attempting to use the device, you will be prompted to enter a department ID and PIN.

Department ID and PIN are unique to you and will be provided at check-in.

MAC INSTALLATION & SETUP

This software should work on all Mac computers still supported by Apple.

Architecture Compatibility:

Works with Mac OS 14, 15, & 26.

STEP 1: OBTAIN [MAC-CANON-PRINTDRIVER.ZIP](#)

This can also be found on the Canon Support website <https://www.usa.canon.com/support>.

Type “C259” in the search box, “imageRUNNER ADVANCE DX C259iF” will be the first available option. Click.

The first listed driver will be UFR II_V10.19.23_mac.zip (last updated 10/10/25 – a newer version may be available.)

Download this file.

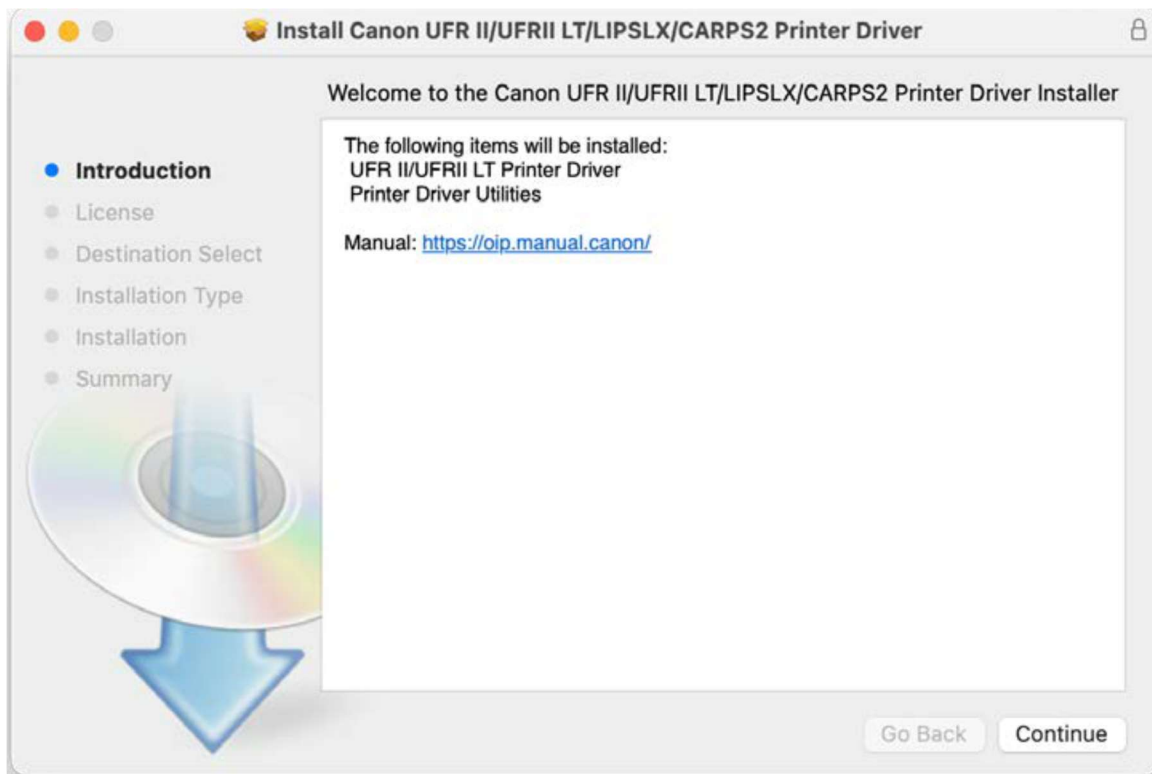
STEP 2: OPEN THE DOWNLOADED ZIP FILE AND RUN “UFR II_V10.19.23_mac.zip”

Most Macs will automatically open the zip file and create a folder with the same name.

STEP 3: THE APPLICATION IS STARTED.

A window will appear explaining what the software is (Canon Drivers).

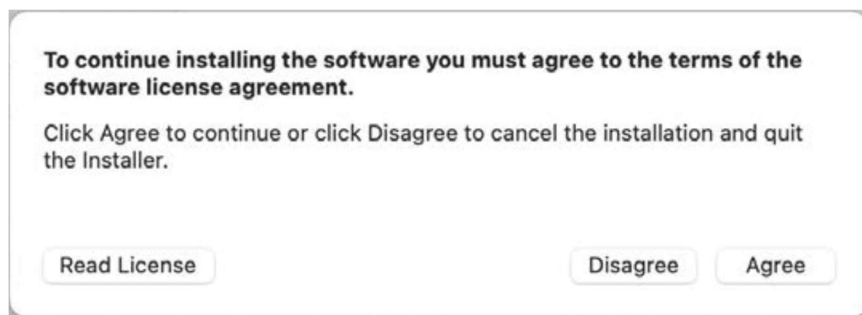
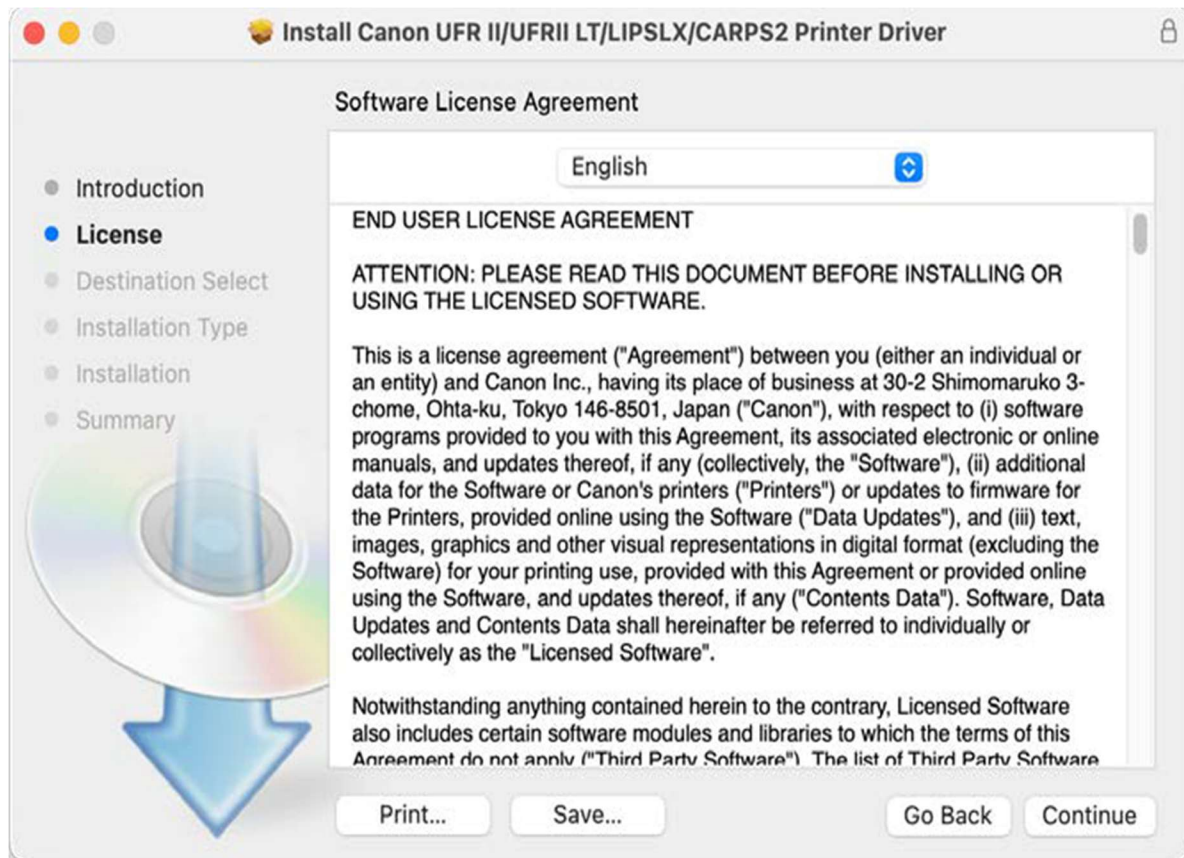
Select “Continue”



STEP 4: EULA

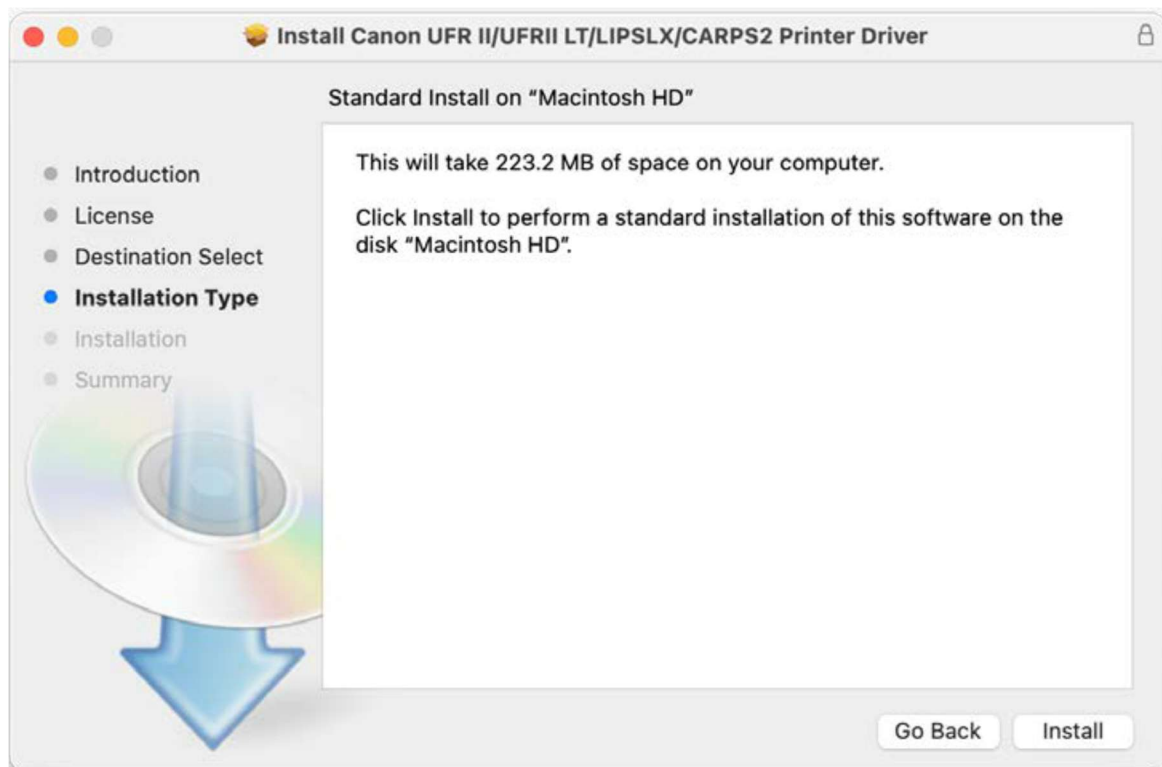
All users of Canon products must agree to the EULA before they can use the software.

Select "Continue" Then "Agree"

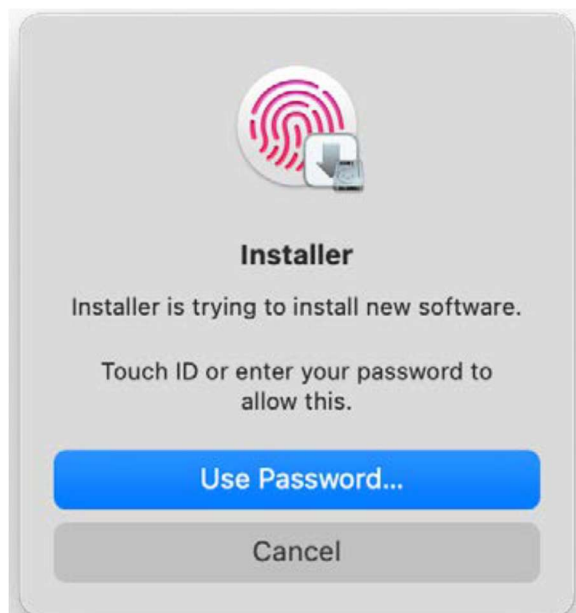


STEP 5: VERIFICATION OF INSTALLATION AND SPACE REQUIREMENTS

Select "Install"

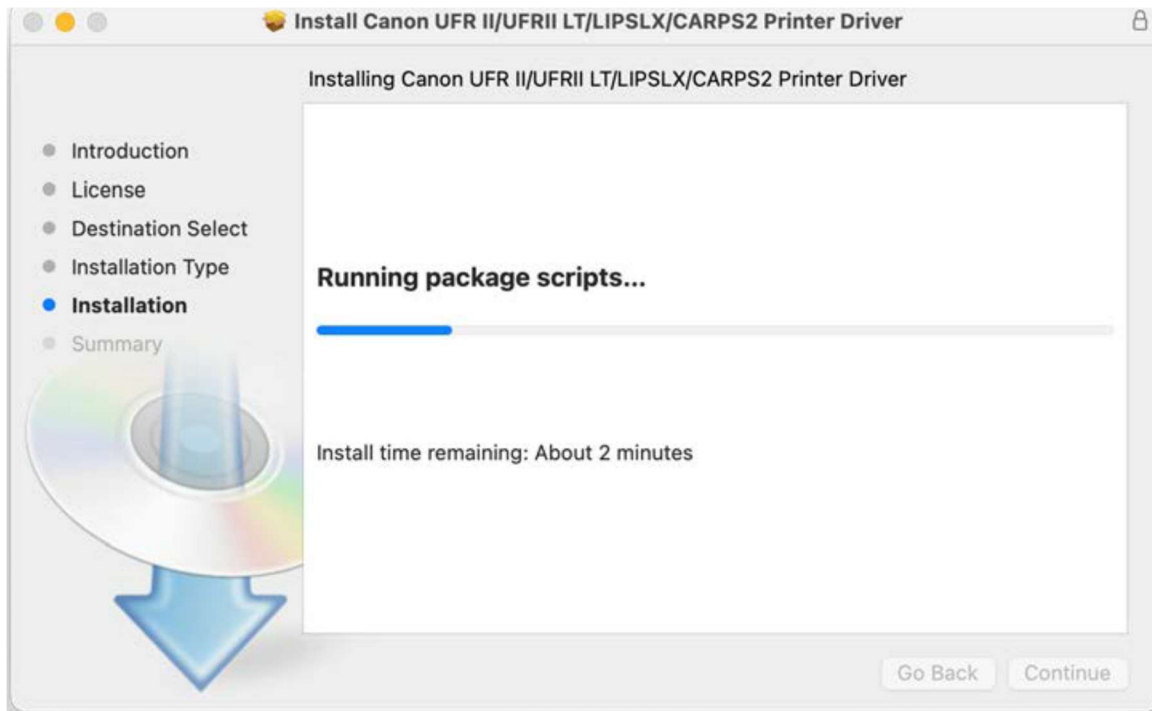


Then enter your password or use "Touch ID" to authenticate that you have chosen to proceed.



STEP 6: INSTALLATION

Installation can take several minutes.

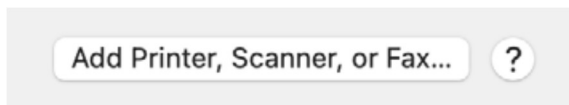


STEP 7: SYSTEM SETTINGS

Once complete, close the window and go to "System Settings"

At the bottom of the list on the left is "Printers &Scanners"

Select "Add Printer, Scanner, or Fax" at the bottom right of the window.



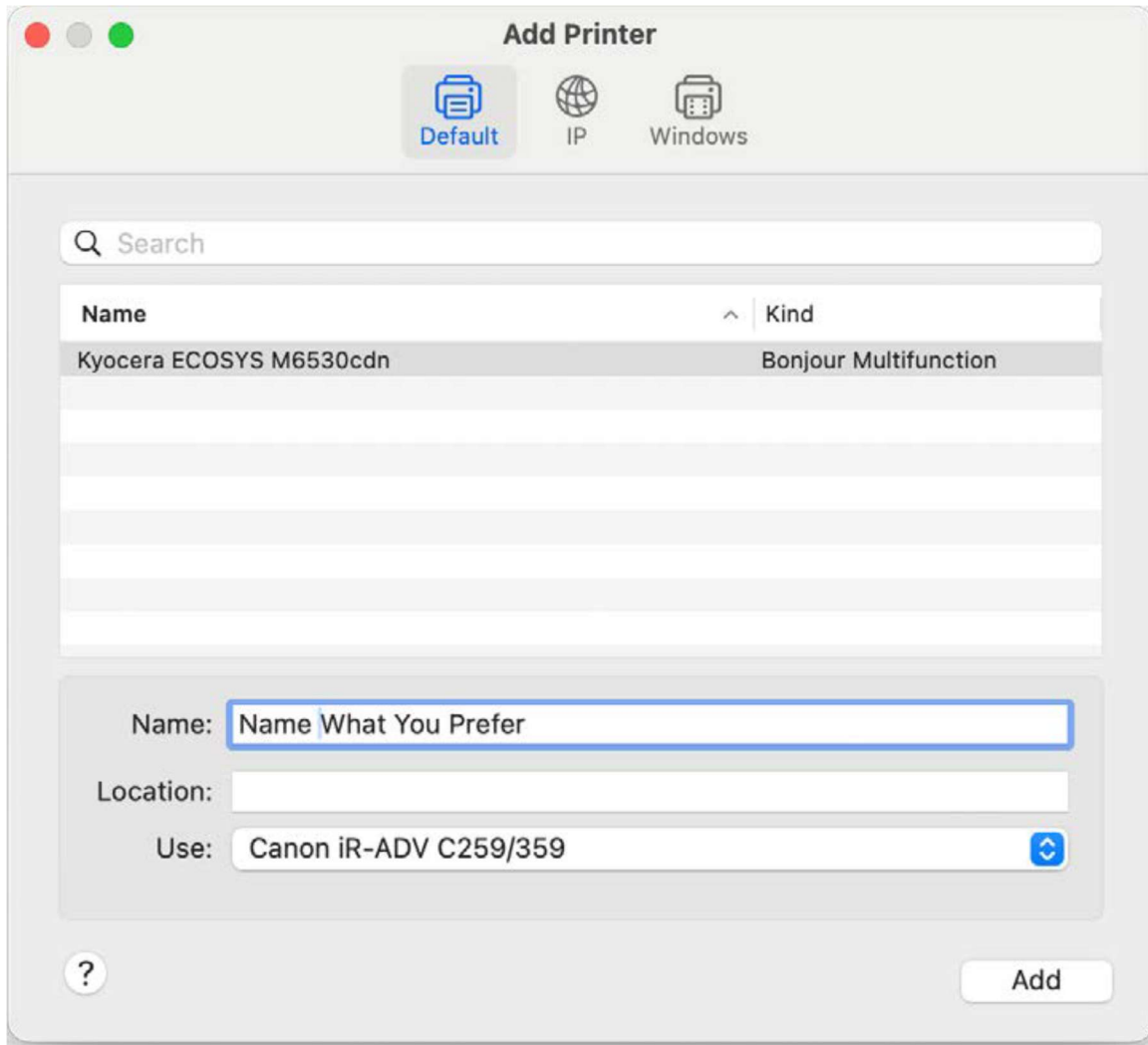
STEP 8: SELECTING THE PRINTER.

(Sorry, Everyone, I am using a Kyocera copier because it is the only one available at the moment. I don't own a Mac, and Canon doesn't provide decent instructions!)

You will find the Canon copier once you're connected to the correct wireless network.

Select the Canon Copier.

"Name" can be set to any name without affecting functionality.



STEP 9: SELECT THE CORRECT DRIVER

Select the “Use” drop-down menu

Then select “Select Software”

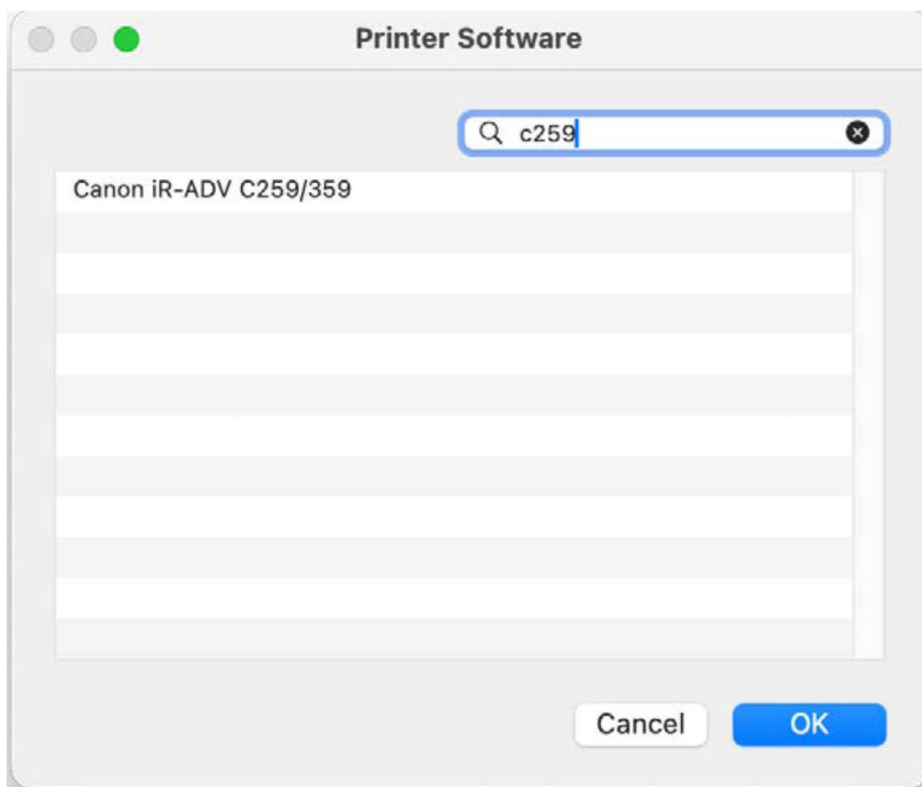


STEP 10: USE PRINTER SOFTWARE

You can either search using the search box or scroll through the list.

Select “Canon IR-ADV C259/359”

Then Select “OK”



INSTALLATION COMPLETE
